Justin Portal Welby's Archbishop of Canterbury Primate of All England presented a list of these rules in the Facebook office in London.

The rules are created to combat abusive and misleading content. Users are encouraged to be respectful, kind, honest, responsible for what is said or written. Also, believers are urged to follow the rules of the social networks themselves, and in case of violations by other users, inform the management of the social network.

Be kind. The best in people. If you have a criticism or critique to make it, you can use it.

Be honest. Don't mislead people about who you are.

Take responsibility. You are accountable for you. Text and images. If you're not sure don't post it.

Be a good ambassador. Can be blurred online so you can before you post.

Disagree well. It's important that we apply them.

Credit others. Acknowledge the work of others. Respect copyright and always credit where it is due. If you are considering amplifying.

Follow the rules. Various media social platforms themselves. If you see our policies, then please report them to the respective company.
