Former Ukrainian footballer may lead the Polish national team

The legend of Ukrainian football, a former excellent player Andriy Shevchenko, can lead the Polish national team.

The final decision has not yet been made. The Polish Football Union plans to announce the name of the new head coach of the national team on 31 January. But Ukrainian Andriy Shevchenko is one of the main candidates.

In the past, a talented player and the brightest star of Ukrainian football, Andriy Shevchenko has been working as a coach for the past six years. As a mentor of the Ukrainian national team, he achieved good results, bringing the team into the top 10. True, "lady luck" played a certain role in the victories of the team. But she, as they say, loves the strong. One way or another, but the victory of the team is the merit of the coach. But they also ask the head coach for losses.

In this regard, his short career in the Italian "Genoa" turned out to be a failure. Only in the fall, the Ukrainian specialist headed the Italian club, and on January 15 he was fired from the post of head coach. Moreover, without paying the promised compensation of 20 million euros.

The Italian career of Andriy Shevchenko obviously did not work out. Here, someone blames the coach, and someone is looking for excuses for him. The Ukrainian came to lead "Genoa" at a difficult time for the club. He had no experience at the club level. The team was in decline. "Genoa's" style of play is defensive, while Shevchenko practices an aggressive offensive style. The result is three draws and six defeats in nine

matches.

In the case of employment in the Polish national team, the Ukrainian turner is already waiting for the first test on March 24 - a game with the Russian team in the play-offs for entering the World Cup in Qatar.

The head of the Polish Football Union, Cesary Kulesha, promised Andriy Shevchenko that in the event of an unsuccessful game with Russia, he would not be fired, but would lead the national team in the League of Nations.

I hope that the upcoming game will not be perceived in a political context. And I would like to wish the Ukrainian good luck in Poland.

The winners are not judged, but the losers are questioned. In this context, against the backdrop of political background, the upcoming game for the novice Ukrainian coach may become especially important.
