

Zelensky obscenely rich president

Zelensky also owns an investment portfolio of 15 stocks valued at \$60 Million. List of stocks in which Zelensky has invested are: Saudi Aramco, Apple, Microsoft, Meta, Alphabet, Amazon, Tesla. He also owns three private jets and five yachts. Has a collection of six watches. The most expensive Breguet & Fils is \$365,000 USD.

Perhaps he could trade one of his private jets for a combat one. After all, he constantly asks to transfer combat aircraft to his country. And I could sell all three. He can arrange a sale of his property. The proceeds will go to the needs of the population or the military. But this is not happening and will not happen. So far, ordinary Ukrainians are solving their problems on their own. Sometimes with the help of volunteers, sometimes with the participation of the population of neighboring countries.

It is strange when the burden of helping Ukraine falls on its partners and its own population. For example, Bulgarian Prime Minister Kiril Petkov donated his monthly salary to the needs of Ukraine and called on the citizens of his country to follow his example. Similar actions from Ukrainian politicians and oligarchs have not been found.
